The Federal Government has declared a State of Emergency due to the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Our Governor issued a Public Health Disaster Emergency Declaration and our Fairbanks North Star Borough has closed borough public spaces in an effort to slow the spread of the virus.

Effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020 the City of North Pole City Hall, Police and Fire Departments will be closed to the public until Monday, May 4, 2020. All council meetings for the month of April have been suspended. The term of closure is subject to change based on the health concerns for our citizens, employees, and councilmembers. Notice will be posted on the City's web site, www.northpolealaska.com, and will be updated as changes become necessary.

Utility payments may be made by using the Bill Box located by the City Hall main entrance at 125 Snowman Lane, electronically on-line, or by phone by calling 488-8538. Utility applications for service may be dropped in the Bill Box at City Hall.
