

The City of North Pole wants to know if you are in favor of or opposed to having streetlights in your neighborhood?



The City of North Pole has Fairbanks Metropolitan Area Transportation Systems (FMATS) funding to install streetlights in your subdivision-neighborhood next year. The project scope includes standardization and new installation of streetlights in the Ford, Morning Star and Highway Park Subdivisions. The Project estimate is \$1.65 million of which the City would contribute a 'match' from the capital projects fund and general fund of up to \$236,000. The City Council supported this project in Resolution 14-10. If we receive no response we will assume you are unopposed to this proposal.
